

Instructions

These instructions are dedicated to doctoral students whose thesis started between 1st September 2023 and 1st March 2024 as well as post doctoral students.

1 – Poster

This poster will present the study subject and will enhance the richness of the work done, the scientific results and the innovations provided.

Authorized languages: French or English

The best posters will be rewarded during the prizes ceremony.

a) For the on-site posters sessions

These posters will be presented on boards.

You have to bring your poster color printed at A0 format : 84 x 118.9 cm (« Portrait » format).

The layout is free but the following mandatory mentions have to appear:

- Laboratory logo,
- CNES logo (top right of the poster)
- State Logo (top left of the poster)
- and eventually logo of the « partners »
- Layout in the grey zone is free

b) For the JC2 website

You have to provide us with a pdf file of your poster (at **A4 format**, file lower than 4 Mo) to be published in the JC² 2025 website.

Technical instructions: pdf file, 1 page at A4 format, lower than 4 Mo.

Before uploading your presentation, please name the file: name_firstname.pdf

Upload deadline: Wednesday 1 October 2025

A few tips:

You can place one or more logos side by side in the top right-hand corner in the “logotype zone” (CNES logo + other “main partner” logos) and place one or more other logos in the bottom right-hand corner in the “secondary partner” zone.

Make sure that all titles and texts are located in the “expression zone”, i.e. the large gray area below the logos.

2 – Oral presentation

Each student will have 3 minutes to present his/her work. The presentation will be based on 4 slides maximum, with the following mandatory elements:

- The title
- The subject of the thesis
- Your name
- The name of the CNES manager
- The laboratory and the eventual partners

Your presentation, like a trailer, has to convince the audience to see your poster.

It will have to be attractive and understandable by non-specialists. For this purpose, do not hesitate to illustrate your slides with pictures, outlines, etc.

Recommendations: you can remind the reason, the issues and the first results of your work and organize a few rehearsals to respect the 3 minutes format!

Technical instructions: PowerPoint 2000 file, duration of the presentation: 3 minutes maximum (PDF format also authorized).

Authorized languages: French or English
