



## Oral presentation

This year the CNES Young Researchers Days are held in a virtual meeting. This leads us to change the format and the course of these meetings.

The Powerpoint presentation, in the form of a pdf file, will be the basis of your intervention (no poster session this year). Your pdf will be available online from the start of the JC2 week.

Your presentation will be contained in a single Pdf file according to this format:

- **A first part to be presented live, in five minutes:** 4 to 6 slides maximum with the following elements: Presentation (1 slide), subject / objective (1 slide), material and method (1 to 2 slides), first results or expected results (1 to 2 slides).
- An “Annexes” separation slide
- **A second part with some more specialized slides**, to be read by your interested colleagues, to help the exchanges of the discussion which will follow. They must not be presented live

Your presentation, such as a trailer, should provide enough information to prompt questions from specialist, expert or curious listeners. **It should be understandable by all and attractive to all.** To achieve this goal, do not hesitate to illustrate your presentation with photos, plots, etc. The annex will be more academic to serve as a basis for a discussion.

**Recommendations:** Recall the context, the issues, the method and the initial results of your work. To last the 5 minutes, organize a few rehearsals beforehand!

**Technical instructions:** Provide a PDF format, in French or English, without videos or animations, respecting the presentation template to be downloaded from the site.
